Greetings and Introductions:

1. **Hola** – Hello
2. **¿Cómo estás?** – How are you?
3. **Buenos días** – Good morning
4. **Buenas tardes** – Good afternoon
5. **Buenas noches** – Good evening / Good night
6. **¿Cuál es tu nombre?** – What is your name?
7. **Me llamo [name].** – My name is [name].
8. **Mucho gusto** – Nice to meet you
9. **¿De dónde eres?** – Where are you from?
10. **Soy de [country].** – I am from [country].



Basic Communication:

1. **¿Hablas inglés?** – Do you speak English?
2. **No hablo mucho español.** – I don't speak much Spanish.
3. **¿Puedes ayudarme?** – Can you help me?
4. **¿Qué significa [word]?** – What does [word] mean?
5. **¿Puedes repetirlo, por favor?** – Can you repeat that, please?
6. **¿Dónde está el baño?** – Where is the bathroom?
7. **Perdón, ¿dónde está [place]?** – Excuse me, where is [place]?
8. **No entiendo.** – I don't understand.

At the Airport:

1. **¿Dónde está el mostrador de facturación?** – Where is the check-in counter?
2. **¿A qué hora sale el vuelo a [destination]?** – What time does the flight to [destination] leave?
3. **¿Dónde está la puerta de embarque?** – Where is the boarding gate?
4. **Tengo una reserva.** – I have a reservation.
5. **¿Dónde puedo recoger mi equipaje?** – Where can I pick up my luggage?

In a Taxi or Public Transport:

3. **¿Dónde está la estación de tren/autobús?** – Where is the train/bus station?
4. **¿Cómo llego a [place]?** – How do I get to [place]?
5. **¿A qué hora sale el próximo bús/tren?** – What time does the next bus/train leave?

At a Restaurant:

1. **Una mesa para [number], por favor.** – A table for [number], please.
2. **¿Qué me recomiendas?** – What do you recommend?
3. **Tengo una reserva.** – I have a reservation.
4. **¿Me puede traer el menú?** – Can you bring me the menu?
5. **¿Cuáles son los platos del día?** – What are the daily specials?
6. **¿Está incluido el servicio?** – Is the tip included?
7. **La cuenta, por favor.** – The check, please.
8. **¿Tienen comida vegetariana/vegana?** – Do you have vegetarian/vegan food?



Shopping:

1. **¿Cuánto cuesta esto?** – How much does this cost?
2. **¿Tienen [item]?** – Do you have [item]?
3. **¿Puedo pagar con tarjeta?** – Can I pay with a credit card?
4. **¿Me puede dar un descuento?** – Can you give me a discount?
5. **¿Dónde está el baño?** – Where is the bathroom?

Emergencies:

1. **¡Ayuda!** – Help!
2. **¿Dónde está el hospital?** – Where is the hospital?
3. **He perdido mi pasaporte.** – I've lost my passport.
4. **Necesito un médico.** – I need a doctor.
5. **¿Hay una farmacia cerca?** – Is there a pharmacy nearby?
6. **Me siento mal.** – I don't feel well.
7. **¿Puedes llamar a la policía?** – Can you call the police?




Money and Payments:

1. **¿Dónde está el cajero automático?** – Where is the ATM?
2. **¿Aceptan tarjetas de crédito?** – Do you accept credit cards?
3. **¿Cuánto cuesta este producto?** – How much does this product cost?
4. **¿Puedo pagar en efectivo?** – Can I pay in cash?
5. **¿Tienes cambio de [amount]?** – Do you have change for [amount]?

Time and Directions:

1. **¿Qué hora es?** – What time is it?
2. **¿Cómo llego a [place]?** – How do I get to [place]?
3. **¿Está lejos?** – Is it far?
4. **¿Está cerca de aquí?** – Is it near here?
5. **Gire a la derecha/izquierda.** – Turn right/left.
6. **Siga todo recto.** – Go straight ahead.

5. **¿Cuánto cuesta por noche?** – How much is it per night?
6. **¿El desayuno está incluido?** – Is breakfast included?
