



## USEFUL TRAVEL PHRASES

When travelling, it's useful to know how to ask for the cost of items whether it's at the market, or the price of a travel ticket. You might also want to start a conversation with a new friend and exchange a phone number! Here are some useful scenarios to help you:

The difference between 5, 15, 50, 500 is a unique number!

**5:** cinco → **SEEN-koh**

**15:** quince → **KEEN-seh**

**50:** cincuenta → **seen-KWEN-tah**

**500:** quinientos → **kee-NYEHN-tohs**
