

Verbos (verbs) - for drinking (Tomar/beber) for Eating (comer)

"TOMAR" - TO TAKE

Yo tomo - I take

Tú tomas - you take (informal).....**usted toma** - you take (formal)

Él, ella toma - he/she takes

Nosotros tomamos - we take

ustedes toman - you take (latín america).....**Vosotros tomáis** - you take (Spain)

Ellos/ellas, toman - they take

"BEBER" - TO DRINK

You bebo- I drink

Tú bebes - you drink (informal)**Usted bebe** - you drink (formal)

Él, ella bebe - he/she drinks

Nosotros bebemos - we drink

Ustedes beben - you drink (latín Sp).....**Vosotros bebéis** - you drink (plural, Spain)

Ellos, ellas beben - they drink

"COMER" - TO EAT

Yo como - I eat

Tú comes - you eat (informal).....**usted come** (you eat, formal)

el/ella come - he/she eats

nosotros comemos - we eat

ustedes comen (you eat, plural, Latin america).....**vosotros coméis** - you eat (pl., Spain)

ellos/ellas comen - they eat

"QUERER" - TO WANT

Yo quiero - I want

Tú quieres - you want (informal).....**usted quiere** (you eat, formal)

el/ella quiere- he/she wants

nosotros queremos - we want

ustedes quieren - you want (plural, Latin America)...**vosotros quereis** -you want (pl, Spain)



ellos/ellas queréis
